



Minor Home Rehabilitation Program

This is a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program that offers grants for eligible low- and moderate-income senior residents (Age 55+) for minor rehabilitation projects to help improve health & safety standards and mobility. Minor housing rehabilitation grants of up-to \$17,255 are available on a first-come, first-serve basis for eligible single-family homes, based on funding availability.
